

## TXT Banking Commands

- BAL** gives you the balances of your TXT banking enabled TSB Bank accounts.
- BAL** plus a <short code> gives you the balance, available balance and the last three transactions of the requested TSB Bank account.
- LIS** plus a <short code> gives you the balance and at least six transactions of the requested TSB Bank account.
- DIS** disables your TXT Banking until you re-enable it via the HomeBank website.
- USE** gives you details of how many times you have used TSB Bank TXT Banking.
- WDL** plus a <short code> gives you the balance and at least six withdrawal transactions that have occurred within the past 90 days.
- DEP** plus a <short code> gives you the balance and at least six deposit transactions that have occurred within the past 90 days.
- TFR** plus <'from' short code> <'to' short code> <amount> this instantly transfers the amount from the 'from' account to the 'to' account and returns the new account balances. **Example: TFR SAV1 MYCHQ 100.**
- VIS** gives you the balance and 'as at' date of each of your TSB Bank VISA card accounts.
- HEL** gives you a list of TXT Banking commands.



**Important info:** TSB Bank receives a commission on each TXT Banking message. TSB Bank TXT Banking is only available in New Zealand and operates with both Vodafone and Telecom SMS capable phones.
